## THE CITY OF ATCHISON

The International Forest of Friendship is located in the historic City of Atchison, Kansas, on the banks of the Missouri River.

It is a progressive industrial city, but also a tourist's delight with a beautiful pedestrian Mall, many Victorian homes and 11 buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Buildings. A Visitors Center in the fully-restored Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Freight Depot (circa 1880) offers trolley and walking tours, information and gifts.

Especially favored for viewing are the Amelia Earhart Birthplace and Museum; the Evah C. Cray Historical Home Museum, a 25-room, full-furnished Victorian mansion; the Muchnic Art Gallery, Atchison Rail Museum and the Atchison County Historical Museum.

It is always a surprise to visitors to find that this Kansas town is not flat. Residential areas grace the river bluffs and descend to the business district in the valley. The rolling hills caused great grief in 1958, when Atchison was nearly destroyed by twin floods that swelled creeks to a wall of water rushing to the river. To ensure this disaster would never occur again, the U.S. Corps of Engineers constructed 25 watershed dams around the city. The largest, named Warnock Lake and surrounded by spacious green park land, is the site of the Forest of Friendship. **CHSNE 020-007**

Atchison was born in 1854, but its location was discovered 50 years earlier. In 1804, the exploring team of Lewis & Clark, traveling up the river by boat, came to the juncture of the wide Missouri and an inbound creek on the evening of the Fourth of July. They camped overnight at what is now the foot of Commercial Street, and, in honor of the day, named the stream Independence Creek.

They were the first of the famous. Atchison is known widely as the birthplace of the world's best known female flier, Amelia Earhart (July 24, 1897), the home of the Santa Fe railroad, (first train out in 1872), and the founding of the Benedictine Abbey, (1857).

The Order of St. Benedict's established a men's college in 1859 and the Benedictine Sisters began a girl's school, the Academy of Mt. St. Scholastica, in 1863. A women's college followed in 1923 and it and St. Benedict's College were combined into Benedictine College in 1971 on the historic campus housing the original abbey and the beautiful Abbey Church.

Education is important in Atchison. Besides the college, there are three secondary schools, Atchison High School, Maur Hill Prep School and Mount St. Scholastica Academy. The local school board currently is constructing a new elementary school complex that will house all children in the district instead of the five buildings now in use. In addition, there are three parochial schools on that level.

Live theater is presented at Theatre Atchison and the drama department of the college. Atchison also is home to one of the finest hospitals in the area and a public library offering many services besides a complete assortment of books.

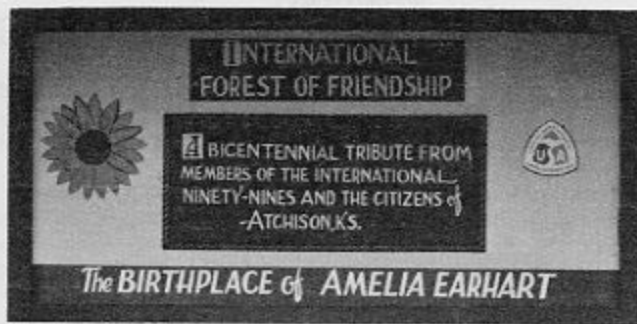
Restaurants are plentiful, including fine dining at Drury-Pennell House in a Victorian setting. Golfing is available at Bellevue and Pineview Country Clubs and both offer meals. Shopping is a delight on the pedestrian Mall.

Industry is alive and well with Midwest Grain Products, Inc., Atchison Casting Corp., Northwest Pipe and Casing Co., Atchison Yarn Factory, Blish-Mize, Atchison Pattern Works, Lockwood Company, ConAgra Corn Processing, Atchison Products, Saunders Mfg. Co. and Unit Rail Anchors.

Atchison has 30 churches representing 17 denominations, an active Family YMCA, United Way and Red Cross.

Small planes land at Amelia Earhart Memorial Airport and Kansas City International is only 40 minutes away. In addition, Atchison forms a hub for three nearby cities; St. Joseph, MO, 15 minutes to the north; Kansas City, one hour south and Topeka, KS, one hour southwest.

## The Forest and How It Came To Be



The International Forest of Friendship is a living, growing memorial to the World History of Aviation and Aerospace.

The Forest was a gift to America on her 200th birthday (1976) from the City of Atchison and the Ninety-Nines, the international organization of women pilots. Atchison, Kansas, is the birthplace of Amelia Earhart who was the first President of the Ninety-Nines.

The Forest is nestled on a gentle slope, overlooking Lake Warnock, in the heartland of America. It is made up of trees representing all the fifty states and territories and the thirty-five countries around the world. The roots of the trees, deeply entwined in the rich Kansas soil are symbolic of the 99s' motto "World Friendship through flying". Each tree has its own flag and on special occasions the Forest is ablaze with the brilliance of colors of more than 100 flags blowing in the breeze. [CHSNE 020-007](http://CHSNE.020-007)

Among the special trees are one from George Washington's Mount Vernon estate, the Bicentennial American Spruce, a tree from Earhart's grandfather's farm and the newly planted redbud from President Eisenhower's farm.

Winding through the Forest is Memory Lane, honoring those who have or still are contributing to all facets of aviation and aerospace. Embedded in the concrete walk (five feet wide to accommodate wheelchairs) are granite plaques engraved with the names of more than 700 honorees.

Included are such internationally recognized flyers as Amelia Earhart, Charles Lindbergh, Jeana Yeager, Rajiv Gandhi, the Wright Brothers, Sally Ride, Chuck Yeager, Beryl Markham, General "Jimmie" Doolittle, President Bush and Gen. Colin Powell.

In 1976, Secretary of the Interior Kleppe dedicated Memory Lane as the first National Recreation Trail in Kansas.

Memory Lane honorees are proposed by sponsors who contribute \$300 to the Forest to help defray cost and installation of the 12"x16"x4½" granite plaque. ## Astronauts' Memorial Around The Moon Tree



The 10th anniversary of the tragic explosion of the space shuttle Challenger will be remembered with a memorial service this year at the Moon Tree in the Forest. Seven astronauts died in the accident. The names of these pioneers of space exploration, along with three other astronauts who also gave their lives, are immortalized in the inner circle around the tree. The Moon Tree was grown from a seed taken to the moon by a Command Module pilot, the late Stuart Roosa, in Apollo 14. The honored dead are Christa McAuliffe, Ronald McNair, Ellison S. Onizuka, Judith A. Resnik, Francis R. Scobee, Michael J. Smith, Edward H. White II, Roger B. Chaffee, Virgil I. (Gus) Grissom and Gregory B. Jarvis. Names of other NASA honorees are in the outer circle.

### BRONZE STATUE OF AMELIA EARHART AT THE FOREST OF FRIENDSHIP

This year marks the 99th birthday of Amelia Earhart, who was one of the founders of the Ninety-Nines in 1929. Adding another double nine, the organization of women fliers was named for the 99 charter members. The daring Amelia, who left her signature "first woman to" on many aspects of early aviation, was the first president of the Ninety-Nines.

Today, there are more than 6,500 members worldwide. In addition to leading support to the Forest of Friendship, the organization has many projects to promote friendship through flying, opening lines of communication through all facets of aviation and aerospace.

Of special note are the Amelia Earhart Scholarships, funded by the issuance each year of a new cover featuring the Amelia Earhart eight-cent Commemorative Air Mail stamp. The first day of issue of the stamp was in 1963 in Atchison.

Ninety-Nines also sponsors safety seminars, supports the regional and national meets for the National Intercollegiate Flying Associates, sponsors competition to choose the United States precision-flying team to compete in world competition and sponsors the Powder Puff Derby.



### THE AMELIA EARHART BIRTHPLACE 223 N. TERRACE ATCHISON, KANSAS

On the eve of Amelia Earhart's centennial year, the famous flier's Atchison birthplace faces major restoration to return it to its original beauty and save it for future generations. It is an exciting and wonderful time for those who revere the flier and her childhood home. [CHSNE 020-007](http://www.chsne.org)

The historical white frame house is located on the bluffs above the Missouri River; the hill near downtown Atchison where Amelia played as a child. Now the property belongs to the International Ninety-Nines and is open to the public as a museum of Earhart artifacts and furniture of the era in which she lived.

A fund drive has been mounted for the ambitious restoration and all donations are gratefully accepted. Both Atchison and Ninety-Nines trustees of the property are promoting and directing the drive.

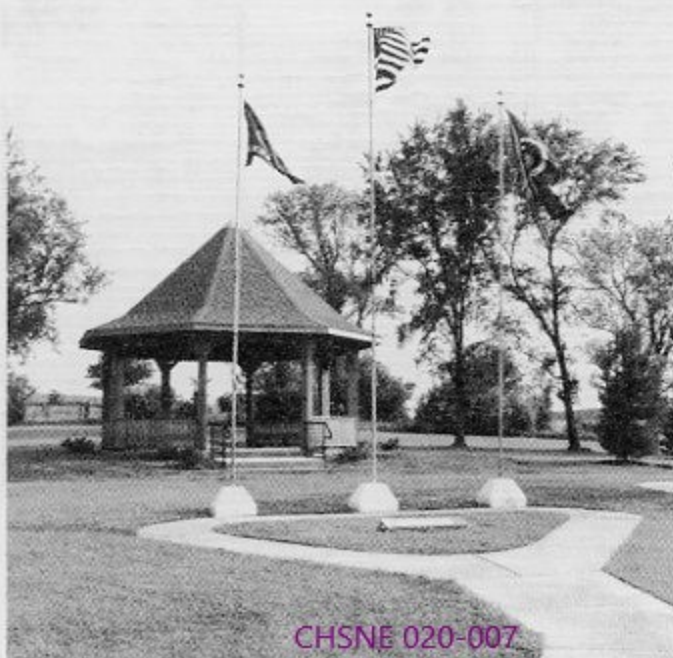
The Earhart Birthplace Museum will be deeply involved in next year's celebration of Amelia's 100th birthday on July 24. A year-long series of events is being planned for Atchison by the Centennial Committee and visitors are expected to number in the thousands.

Formerly the residence of the late Paul and Winney Allingham, owners of the Atchison Daily Globe and staunch backers of the Forest of Friendship, the birthplace was given to the Ninety-Nines through the generosity of Dr. Eugene B. Bribach, internationally-known local physician, who purchased it from Allingham heirs in 1984.

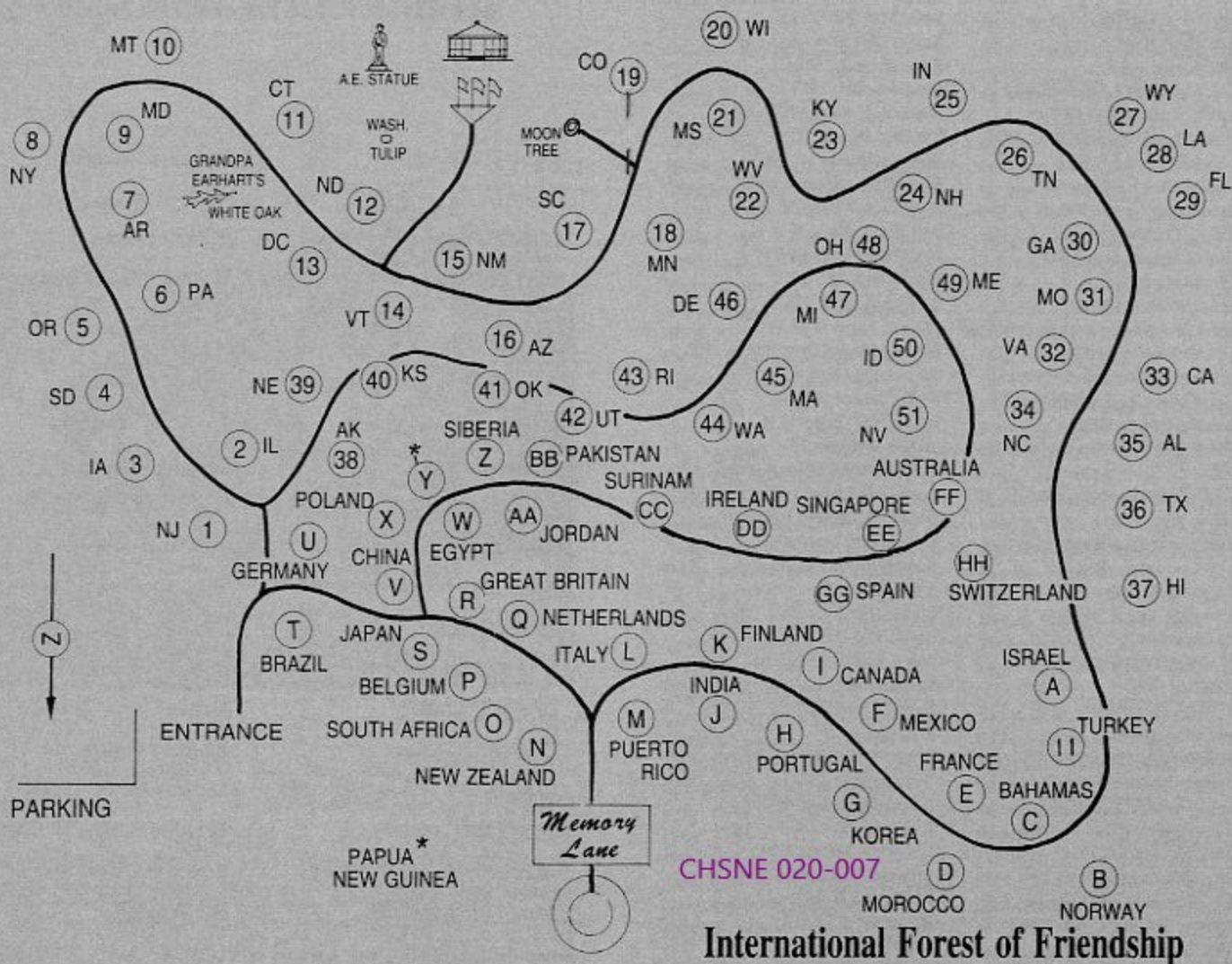
